

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Bacon Treasurer of the Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf & Dumb or order eight hundred and forty eight dollars eighty seven cents for tuition, support & of indigent pupils of the State of Maryland at said Institution as provided for by Law, of account.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order one hundred and eighty dollars for the purchase of fuel, to be accounted for.

Saturday November 5th 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John J. Audubon or order sixty dollars for Books for the Library, under Resolution of the General Assembly, of certificate of the Librarian.

Monday November 3rd 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Elizabeth Simmons or order six dollars seventy five cents for one quarter salary for cleaning the Public Temple, due the first Instant.

Friday November 7 1834

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to William Schwartz, on account of Stealing to the amount of \$1.99, which he had been convicted on Indictment in Baltimore City Court, at October Term 1834.

Wednesday November 11th 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Tuck or order seventy one dollars seventy five cents, for cleaning and repair of stoves, under Resolution of the General Assembly, of account allowed.

Thursday November 12 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Gully or order one hundred and forty dollars for a Portrait of the late Col John Eager Howard, under Resolution of the General Assembly, of contract with the Governor.

Friday November 13th 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order seven dollars for the purchase of Fuel to be accounted for.

Wednesday November 18 1834

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Mills or order fifteen dollars for one quarter Rent of Magazine due the 3rd Instant.
