

Slave, and also for having stolen and carried away one Coat of the Value, four dollars
one pair of Boots of the Value of one dollar and a half, and one pair of Pistols of the
Value of four dollars, of the goods and chattels of John Ondorf. And whereas a sum
has been received at the Executive Department of this State, that the said Emmanuel
Cuff Butter has fled from Justice and is now confined in the jail of Adamsburg,
State of Pennsylvania. And it being important and highly necessary for the good
of Society, that the perpetrators of such offences should be brought to Justice. Now
therefore, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, by virtue of the
Authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, do hereby
demand the said Emmanuel Cuff Butter as a fugitive from the Justice of this
State and make known to your Excellency that I have appointed George
Riggs my Agent to receive the said fugitive and bring him to this State, having
Jurisdiction of the said offence that he may be brought to trial therefor.

In compliance with the requisitions of the Law, I herewith annex
and produce to your Excellency a copy of the indictment upon which
this Demand is founded; which I certify is authentic.

The following Commission and instruction was issued to the
aforesaid Agent viz

The State of Maryland, To George Riggs, Gentleman
Greetings Be it known, that we, putting great trust and confidence in your
Prudence and honesty, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland,
have appointed you my Agent to receive from His Excellency, the
Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, the body of Emmanuel Cuff
Butter, Negro, a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and I do hereby
authorise and direct you, upon receiving the said fugitive, to bring him
into this State, and convey and deliver him to the Sheriff of Frederick
County, to answer for having enticed Negro Thomas, Slave of John
Ondorf to run away, knowing him to be a Slave, and also for having
stolen and carried away one Box Coat of the Value of one dollar, one
pair of Boots of the Value of one dollar and fifty cents, and one pair
of Pistols of the Value of four dollars, of the goods and chattels of John
Ondorf.
