The following orders were issued by His Excellency the Governor, upon the Command and information and evidence therein mentioned, viz.

The State of Maryland, To the Warden of the Jail of Baltimore County, Greeting. Whereas, it appears from authentic documents, certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency George Wolf, Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain Aaron Grason and James Grason stand charged by affidavit with having stolen one (say) Horse and one (say) Mare, the property of Cony Applemann, of the County of York in the State of Pennsylvania and that the said Aaron Grason and James Grason have fled from the Justice of the said State and are now confined in the Jail of Baltimore County. And whereas the said George Wolf Governor as aforesaid hath in pursuance of the authority given in such case by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said Aaron Grason and James Grason, of the Executive of this State as fugitives from Justice, and appointed Adam Eichelberger his agent to receive the said fugitives and transport them to the said State of Pennsylvania for trial for the said offence. Now therefore, I James Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought proper, in compliance with the said Command to view and direct the removal of the said fugitives and do hereby view and direct that you, forthwith, deliver the said Aaron Grason and James Grason to the said Adam Eichelberger agent as aforesaid, he the said agent first paying all costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitives - for all which this shall be your sufficient warrant.
