The State of Maryland, to wit. Whereas, in compliance with a
Demand of His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania
Army have been given for the surrender of a certain person whose name
is unknown, as a fugitive from the Justice of the said State to Adam
Eichelberger agent Army appointed to receive the said fugitive and trans-
port him to the said State of Pennsylvania; it appearing from authentic
documents transmitted to the Executive Department of this State that the
said unknown person stands charged by affidavit of Andrew Patterson
of the County of York in the State of Pennsylvania, with having stolen
divers goods of said Patterson and a sum of money the amount of which
is not ascertained, and the part of which goods were found in his possession
by Hays & Riggs Peace Officers of the City of Baltimore. It now
therefore, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby
require and enjoin all persons within this State, to let the said Adam
Eichelberger Agent as aforesaid pass with the said fugitive unmolested
to the said State of Pennsylvania, by the said Agent conducting himself
in a peaceable and orderly manner, and using no improper severity
or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.

Record of the conviction of Negro Judah, Slave of John H.
Wayne of Prince Georges County of the Murder of John & Emily Bayne Jr.
having been received His Excellency the Governor this day issues the
following Warrant for the execution of the said Negro Judah viz.
The State of Maryland, to the Sheriff of Prince Georges County,
greeting. Whereas Judah late of Prince Georges County was convicted
in Prince Georges County Court at November Term 1834 of the Murder
of John & Emily Bayne Jr. and by the said Court sentenced to be hanged by
the neck until he be dead. It now therefore, there are to wit and
require as also to charge and command you that, on or before the first day of the
Egdom on Friday the thirteenth day of January Instant, you take the
said Negro Judah from your prison and remove safely convey to the gallows
in the County aforesaid, the place of the execution of Malefactors and
there the said Negro Judah hang by the neck until he be dead, you all
