The Council met Present the same as on yesterday.

George M West Robert Bone and Abraham Deas Esquires,  
Commissioners appointed to view and examine the Turnpike Road from Frederick  
to Harper's Ferry, and to report to His Excellency the Governor whether the said Road  
had been improved three miles four furlongs and thirty one perches, beginning at  
the end of fifteen miles on said Road, and running thence to Harper's Ferry, in a  
workmanlike manner, according to the true intent and meaning of the act in incorporating  
the Company for making said Road, and the supplement thereto, having made  
their Report in Writing in the affirmative, His Excellency the Governor, this  
day issued his License authorizing the said Company to receive the Tolls allowed  
by its charter passing on said Road. (See Turnpike Road Record).

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Lanning  
or order one hundred and sixty nine dollars thirty eight cents for balance of a  
quarter's salary as Examiner General (after deducting the amount of fees received  
due the first Instant).

His Excellency the Governor granted a Pardon Provisory to  
John Gibson on account of charges of forging or counterfeiting the names  
of Horatio G. Jameson, John Ford, Samuel Reed, William McCracken,  
William McHenry and William McDonald and others.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Elijah Wells  
or order for cleaning the inner dome and Hall of the State, by order of  
the Executive, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Br.  
-ington G. Peck or order four hundred and forty dollars eighty seven cents  
for cleaning and repair of floors, by order of the Executive, under  
of the General Assembly, of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Geo.  
-riggs or order thirty five dollars seven ty seven cents for bringing a Justice  
from Pennsylvania to this State, of amount allowed.
