On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council, the following civil appointments were made and commissions issued accordingly. Viz

James B. Stansbury, Edward Lucas and Amos G. Sp. Coroners for the City of Baltimore.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah Hughes or order the sum one hundred and sixty one dollar and fifty cents for printing done for the State & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel Map or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the first day of January last.

His Excellency the Governor this granted an unconditional Nolle Prosequi to Thomas Clagett, on a count of the offence charged against him and on which he had on the eighth day of March 1834 granted a Conditional Nolle Prosequi, thereby remitting or revoking said condition. (See Pardon Record).
