Thursday February 12th 1835

The Council met, Present the same as on yesterday

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and  
with the advice and consent of the Council Doctor William S. McSherry  
was appointed Surgeon Mate of the 40th Regiment of the Militia of this State  
in Harford County, and Commission issued to him accordingly.

The following Demand was made upon His Excellency the  
Governor of Virginia for the person therein named as a fugitive from Justice,  
upon application, and the information and evidence therein mentioned being  
filed in the Executive Department, Viz

To His Excellency Littleton W. Tazewell Governor of the State  
of Virginia. Whereas a certain James G. Jones stands charged by the  
affidavit of Sarah Feuster of having on the eleventh day of November last,  
murdered Charles Bloice in Montgomery County, in this State. And whereas  
information has been received at the Executive Department of this State,  
that the said James G. Jones has fled from Justice, and is now confined in  
the Jail of Jefferson County in the State of Virginia. And it being impor-  
tant and highly necessary for the good of Society, that the perpetrators of  
such offences should be brought to Justice. Now therefore, I James  
Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland, by virtue of the authority vested  
in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, do hereby demand  
the said James G. Jones, as a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and  
make known to your Excellency that I have appointed Henry Lilly my agent  
to receive the said fugitive and bring him to this State, having Jurisdiction
