Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Leakin and Codd or order fifty five dollars, viz \$50 for publishing in the Chronicle Sunday Laws, by direction of the Clerk of the Council, in virtue of orders of the House of Delegates, and five dollars for subscription to the Chronicle for one year, to the first volume, of amount allowed.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council, Robert Lemmon was appointed and auctioneer within the City of Baltimore, and commissions issued to him accordingly.
