

Wednesday February 25 1835.

The Council met. Present the same as on yesterday.

The Honble John S. Martin, member of the Council, elect appeared in the Council chamber this day and qualified as a member of the Council, by taking the Federal oath prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of this State before Edward Debois Esquire, one of the Justices of the peace, for Anne Arundel County, and by repeating, and subscribing a declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Ignatius J. McAttee or order fifteen dollars for expenses of conveying, his son, a State pupil, to the Deaf and Dumb Institution in Philadelphia, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel Anderson or order ten dollars for expenses of bringing, his son, a State pupil, from the Deaf & Dumb institution in Philadelphia, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John S. Fowler or order ten dollars for going on prep to Upper Marlborough, with a death Warrant, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Isaac Munroe or order five dollars for the Baltimore Parish for one year to the 18th ultimo, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel G. Taylor or order fifteen dollars, fifty cents for freight on trunks by the Steam Boats Maryland and Relief, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Adam and John. Miller or order four dollars & nine cents for sundries for the Executive, & account allowed.

Thursday February 26th 1835.

The Council met. Present the same as on yesterday.

His Excellency the Governor this day delivered to Colo Nathan Towson, of the United States Army, and to Captain John Gallagher of the United States Navy, each a sword, with appropriate devices, for their gallantry and good conduct in the late war with great Britain, as authorized by the General Assembly.
