The following Resolutions in relation to Guarding the State  
Property were passed. Viz.

Resolved that the Guard hired by the Executive, under a  
Resolution of the General Assembly, for the protection of the public property  
in the City of Annapolis, be forthwith dismissed, and that a Watch of  
Six men be employed to carry into effect the object of the Resolution, and  
that the said Watch be allowed one dollar each for every night of service.

Resolved that the thanks of the Executive be presented to Capt.  
Hobbs for the prompt tender of his services as commander of the guard,  
ordered into service by the Executive, under the Resolution of the General  
Assembly passed the 17th ultimo for the protection of the public property,  
and for the efficient discharge of the duties of his appointment.
