

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council the following civil appointments were made and commissions issued accordingly viz

William A Curtis, Edward Waters (Potatoes Neck), George Houston and Elijah C. Anson Additional Justices of the Peace of Somerset County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Cobbin, Murphy & Bond or their order dollars, viz for publishing Supplement to the Law concerning the inspection of Flour, & for publishing two orders of the Assistant General for Districton officers to Report, if amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Lilly, or his order one hundred and eight dollars for compensation and expenses for bringing a fugitive from Justice, from Charles Town Virginia, to Rockville for trial, if amount allowed.

His Excellency the Governor, this day granted a Nolle Prosequi to Robert Pearson, on account of Stealing, with which he was charged by Indictment in Baltimore City Court.
