By the petition of George Healdert and a transcript from the Records of Prince Georges County Court it appears that he was fined by the said Court a 1st November Term 1834 the sum of fifty three dollars thirty three cents for neglecting to keep a bridge in repair over his Mill Dam in Bladensburg. The petitioner represents that at the time he took possession of said Mill, there was not then, neither had there been at any time before to his knowledge any bridge erected over said Mill Race, that to accommodate the inhabitants of the Village he erected four bridges over said Mill Race, all of which have been destroyed by freshets, - he therefore prays for a remission of said fine. And sundry respectable Citizens of said County, including the Chief Judge of said County Court, having recommended the remission of said fine, we do hereby remit the same.
