

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Captain David Stoy or order thirty six dollars forty cents for the payment of the company under his command for services in January 1834 & amount adjusted by the Executive in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly. ↵

Ordered that the Armorer at Annapolis deliver to Captain William Camp or order sixty cavalry swords, pistols and accoutrements for the use of the Troop under his command. ↵

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Mills or order fifteen dollars for one quarter rent of Magazine up to the 3^d ultimo.

Friday March 20th 1835.

The Council met. Present the same as on yesterday.
