Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Doctor Julius T Ducatel or order two hundred and forty eight dollars seventy seven cents for expenses incurred in providing cases to contain Geological Specimens collected by him under a Resolution of the General Assembly, $\$$ amount allowed. ↵

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Messier or order twenty five dollars for Blank forms for the Executive, $\$$ amount allowed. ↵

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Edward P Hammond or order twenty seven dollars forty cents viz $\$19.90$ for sundry articles for the State Library and $\$7.30$ for Stationery for the adjutant General, $\$$ amount allowed. ↵

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G Luck or order one hundred and one dollar twenty cents for removing Arms $\$$ to the new Gun House, packing Arms and mending flag and for firing five Salutes, $\$$ amount allowed. ↵

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel Goldsmith or order two dollars for digging out, filling up and raming around the Gun House, $\$$ amount allowed. ↵

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Sglehart or order twenty seven dollars viz $\$25$ for powder for firing Salutes and $\$2$ for a Penknife, and candles for the Executive, $\$$ amount allowed. ↵

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph Townsend, Treasurer of the Baltimore Equitable Society or order one hundred and twenty one dollar sixty two cents, as a contribution on account of the insurance of the State Tobacco Warehouses, $\$$ amount allowed. ↵

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order seven dollars two cents paid by him for hauling Wood from the Cellar and bringing into the State House, $\$$ amount allowed. ↵
