

Saturday May 2nd 1835

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Elizabeth Simmons or order six dollars seventy five cents for one quarter salary for cleaning the public Temple, due the first Instant.

Friday May 8 1835.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to Thomas Reily on account of beating a Clock and Coat the property of Comfort Tiffany, of which he was convicted in Anne Arundel County Court at April Term 1835, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years.

Saturday May 16th 1835.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard Anderson or order one hundred and twenty dollars for six months pension due the first of April last.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John G. Little or order one hundred and fifty seven dollars seventy six cents for books furnished for the State Library, Particulate of the Librarian, under Resolutions of the General Assembly.
