Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Buff Green or order seven dollars fifty cents for subscription to the Telegraphic Journal 1st of December 1834 to 1st March 1836 & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Reed or order seven dollars sixty two cents for sweeping chimneys in the State and Government Houses, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Charles Willigman Jr or order two dollars for trimming the trees on the State House Hill & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Gideon White and William Brewer or order twelve dollars for taking an inventory and appraising the furniture in the Government House, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Andrew Slicer or order sixty six dollars for thirty three nights services as Captain of the Guard of the State House & under Resolution of the General Assembly, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Philip Clayton or order two dollars for two nights service in guarding the State House under Resolutions of the General Assembly, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Lamb or order thirty three dollars for thirty three nights service in guarding the State House & under Resolution of the General Assembly, & amount allowed.
