Murphy or order three thousand two hundred and forty nine dollars forty two cents for balance of his account for repairs and improvements of Tobacco Warehouses after deducting two thousand five hundred dollars advanced on that account of contract with the Executive by virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly, of amount allowed. ↪

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John C. Dirickson or order three hundred and twenty eight dollars for compensation for his services as commissioner for surveying the Sound between Cape Charles & Lewistown, in virtue of a Resolution of General Assembly. ↪

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Benjamin Hughes or order two thousand seven hundred and seventy two dollars for printing sixteen hundred copies of the Journal of the House of Delegates and making Index thereto, as of contract and amount allowed. ↪

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William McNeir or order one thousand two hundred and thirty two dollars for printing sixteen hundred copies of the Journal of the Senate of amount allowed. ↪

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William G. Jack or order forty dollars seventy cents for removing ammunition & Mills Magazine to the new Gun House of amount allowed. ↪
