

Wednesday July 8 1835.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph St. Nicholson or order thirty seven dollars fifty cents, for one quarters salary as Clerk of the Senate, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Newman or order seventy five dollars, for one quarters salary as drummer at Easton, due the first instant.

Thursday July 9th 1835.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Ogden Niles or order seventy five dollars for publishing in the Frederick Herald Sunday Laws, by order of the Governor Council, under Resolution of the General Assembly.

Friday July 10th 1835.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard J. Crabbe or order seventy nine dollars twenty nine cents, for one quarters postage due the first instant. Viz for the Executive \$52.27, for the Treasurer \$19.28, for the Librarian \$5.84, and for the Assistant General \$1.90 of amount proved.

Friday July 17 1835.

The following order were issued by His Excellency the Governor upon the Demand, and information and evidence therein mentioned viz. The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Cecil County, Greeting: Whereas, it appears from authentic documents, certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency George Wolf, Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain John Eagan late of the County of Lancaster in the said State of Pennsylvania, stands charged on oath, with the crime of fornication and bastardy committed with a certain Catherine Spitzer of the Township of Conestogo in the said County of Lancaster and that the said John Eagan has fled from the Justice of the said State, and is, it is believed now residing in Cecil County, in this State. And whereas, the said George Wolf, Governor as aforesaid, hath in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said John Eagan, of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed James Pinepacker, his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania for trial for the said offence. Now therefore, I James Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought proper, in compliance with the said demand, to order and direct the surrender of the said fugitive, and do hereby order and direct that you, forthwith, arrest and deliver the said John Eagan, if he is to be found within your bailiwick, to the said James Pinepacker, agent as aforesaid, he the said agent first paying all costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitive -
