The State of Maryland, to wit. Whereas, in compliance with a demand  
of His Excellency George Wolf, Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, orders  
have been given for the surrender of a certain John Eagan as a fugitive from  
the Justice of the said State to James Pennepacker agent, duly appointed to  
receive the said fugitive, and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania,  
it appearing from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive Depart-  
ments of this State, that the said John Eagan stands charged on oath,  
with the crime of fornication and bastardy, committed with a certain Catherine  
Nortzen of the Township of Conestoga, in the County of Lancaster, in the said  
State of Pennsylvania, and that the said John Eagan had fled from  
Justice and taken refuge in this State. Now therefore, I James  
Thomas, Governor of the State of Maryland, do hereby require and enjoin  
all persons within this State, to let the said James Pennepacker  
agent as aforesaid, pass with the said fugitive unmolested to the said  
State of Pennsylvania; let the said agent conducting himself in a  
peaceable and orderly manner, and using no improper severity or  
cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to  
Thompson or order one hundred and forty one dollars sixty one cents  
for purchase of firewood, to be accounted for.
