

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Cook or order three hundred and twelve dollars fifteen cents for cleaning, packing and hauling arms and for powder and firing salute, & amounts allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah Hughes or order two thousand two hundred and eighty two dollars seventy five cents viz \$1570 for printing the Laws of the last Session, \$150 for making index sheets, \$150 for delivering the Laws & Journals, \$47.50 for boxes for and packing the same, \$3 for printing certificates to the Laws, \$75 for publishing certain Laws, \$12 for publishing order of the Executive enumerating the same, \$31.25 for twenty copies of Laws and twenty papers sent to Editors, \$5 for publishing notice for proposals for public work, \$297 for printing 264 pages of Revised Code, and Resolutions of the General Assembly, and \$2 for publishing notice of meetings of the Council & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Sullivan and Charles Milliquan or order sixteen dollars fifty cents for cleaning arms under Resolution of the General Assembly & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Gault and John Sullivan or order seventy five dollars for cleaning arms under Resolution of the General Assembly, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Charles Milliquan or order thirty dollars for riding express twice from Annapolis to the Governor, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Matthews or order six dollars for his horse to go express to the Governor, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Evans or order ten dollars for riding express for the Governor, & amount allowed.
