Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Alexander Randall and George E. Franklin or order fifty six dollars thirty seven cents for their expenses in going exp^s to Washington with requisition upon the General Government for Troops, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John W. Whittington or order one hundred and twenty seven dollars twenty five cents for binding Books for the Library, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William H. Hall or order seventy five dollars, for publishing in his paper Sunday Laws by order of the Executive in Virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John W. Watkins or order twenty three dollars fifty six cents for exp^s as a Captain General to Baltimore and back with the Governor, & amount allowed.
