

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Edward Elliott or order seventy five dollars for publishing in the Cecil Whig Sunday Laws, by order of the Executive, in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William D Bell or order seventy five dollars & seventy five cents, viz, \$75 for publishing in the Torch Light Sunday Laws, by order of the Executive, in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly, and of 5 cents for the Torch Light for James Montgomerie Esq during the last Session, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John B. Spencer or order seventy five dollars, for publishing in the Centerville Times Sunday Laws, by order of the Executive, in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly, & account allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Samuel Charles or order seventy five dollars, for publishing in the Cumberland Civilian Sunday Laws, by order of the Executive, in virtue of a Resolution of the General Assembly, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William McMeir or order ninety seven dollars thirty one cents viz, \$50 for balance for making Index to Journal of the Senate and, \$23.75 for boxes and packing Journals of the Senate and \$23.56 for folding and Hitching Maps accompanying the Report of the State Geologist, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James Thomas or order six hundred and sixty six dollars sixty six cents, for one quarters Salary as Governor, due the first ultimo.
