

Saturday September 26th 1835.

The following Order was issued by His Excellency the Governor, upon the Command and information and Evidence therein mentioned. Viz.

The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Cecil or any other County of this State, greeting. Whereas it appears from authentic documents, certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency George Wolf, Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain John Perry stands charged by the affirmation of Margaret McManime of East Nottingham Township in the County of Chester and State of Pennsylvania, with the crime of fornication and bastardy committed with the said Margaret. And it having been represented to me that the said John Perry has fled from the Justice of the State and taken refuge in this State, and it is believed in Cecil County. And whereas the said George Wolf Governor as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said John Perry of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed John A. Bye his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania, for trial for the said offence. Now therefore, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland have thought proper, in compliance with the said Demand, to order and direct the surrender of the said fugitive, and do hereby order and direct, that you, forthwith, arrest and deliver the said John Perry, if he is to be found within your bailiwick, to the said John A. Bye, agent as aforesaid, he the said agent full paying all costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitive. For all which this shall be your sufficient warrant.

The State of Maryland, to-wit: Whereas, in compliance with a demand of His Excellency George Wolf Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, Orders have been given for the surrender of a certain John Perry as a fugitive from the Justice of the said State to John A. Bye, Agent duly appointed to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania: it appearing from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, that the said John Perry stands charged by the affirmation of Margaret McManime of East Nottingham Township in the County of Chester, State of Pennsylvania, with the crime of fornication and bastardy, committed with her the said Margaret: and it having been represented to me by His Excellency Governor Wolf, that the said John Perry has fled from the Justice of the State of Pennsylvania, and taken refuge in the State of Maryland. Now therefore, I James Thomas, Governor
