Tuesday September 29th 1835.

of the General Assembly.

Thursday October 5th 1835.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay David
Ridgely or order two hundred dollars for one quarter salary as Librarian due
this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry
Thompson or order one hundred and twelve dollars fifty cents for one quarter
salary as messenger of the Council, and for taking care of the State House
due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas
Cullbreth or order three hundred and seventy five dollars for one quarter
salary as Clerk of the Council, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington
Ge Duck or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter
salary as Armorer at Annapolis, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Julius
T Ducatob or order five hundred dollars for one quarter salary as Geologist
due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard
Wells or order sixty two dollars fifty cents for one quarter salary as
Steward to the Governor due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas
Kearney or order one hundred and fifty two dollars eight cents for
balance of one quarter salary as Examiner General, after deducting
the amount of fees received, due this day.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay
Ann Levache or order forty dollars for one quarter pension, due ...
