William M. Warte, a Justice of the Peace of the City of Baltimore,
Vice Charles Herman removed from the State.

By the petition of Charles Nathall and a transcript from the
Records of Saint Marys County Court, it appears that the said Charles Nathall
was fined by the said Court, at August Term 1835 the sum of one hundred
dollars for an assault & battery on Thomas Redman. The petitioner states
that he did inflict the blow, for which he was presented by the grand Jury
of St. Marys County, but not until he had received (unprovoked on his part)
the most severe abuse and threats towards himself, and in protecting a female
from a chattement from said Redman, who never knew mercy, when excited
by anger, that he considers said fine severe and oppressive, that the only
witness before the Court was a relation of Redman's and that he evidently
gave a gratified statement throughout, and when questioned by Counsel
refused to state to the Court any of the causes or provocations which led
to the assault. He therefore prays for a remission of said fine. And
many respectable Citizens of said County having recommended a compliance
with the prayer of the petitioner, and expressed their opinions that the fine
was unjust and unwarranted by the testimony - we do hereby remit
said fine so far as payable to the State.

By the petition of Neil Shields and Henry Widdetow, and
transcripts from the Records of Baltimore City Court it appears that they
were, each, fined by the said Court, at October Term 1835, the sum of
twenty dollars for keeping a disorderly House. The Petitioners state that

was selling liquor on a Sunday and that they were not aware of the existence
of the Law they violated, or they should not have done so - they therefore
pray for a remission of said fines. And the said Court having recommended
a compliance with their prayer we do hereby remit said fines, so far as
payable to the State.
