He therefore prays for admission of said fines. And sundry respectable Citizens of said County, having recommended a compliance with the prayer of the petitioner, and it appearing from satisfactory evidence that the petitioner is unable to pay said fines, we do hereby remit the same so far as payable James Thomas to the State
