Tuesday December 29 1834

The Council met, at the Government House. Present  
The same as on yesterday.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay  
Josiah Bayly or order four hundred dollars in full compensation for his  
services as Attorney General in aiding his deputies, by direction of the Executive  
in pursuance of Law, in the several prosecutions growing out of disclosures  
in relation to the failure of the Bank of Maryland and other money  
institutions in the City of Baltimore.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William  
Kavanaugh or order four hundred and twenty four dollars ten cents  
for cleaning, for advertising for returning Arms and for expenses of collecting  
Arms, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay  
William McMein or order sixty five dollars for blank forms for the  
Executive, & amount allowed.

Wednesday December 30 1834

The Council met, at the Government House. Present  
the same as on yesterday.

by and with the advice and consent of the Council, the following judicial  
appointments were made, and commissions issued accordingly, viz.

William Conrad and James Carter, additional Justices of the  
Peace of Allegany County.
