Thomas Curtis Clerk of the Court of Appeals for the Eastern Shore since Parrott resigned.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Coulter or order two hundred and twelve dollars fifty cents for making twenty thousand ball cartridges, by order of the Executive, for amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John W. Alexander or order five hundred dollars, on amount of the contingent expenses of his survey with a view to a new State Map, to be accounted for.

The following demands were made by His Excellency the Governor upon the Executives of the several States of Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Illinois, Ohio, Kentucky and Tennessee, upon the information and evidence therein mentioned. Viz.

To His Excellency Edward S. White, Governor of the State of Louisiana. Where as a certain Leon Syer late of the City of Baltimore stands charged by Indictment, together with George W. Frazer, William Harrison and sundry others, with having on the seventh day of August last and on divers other days and times between that day and the tenth day of August aforesaid, with force and arms, at the City aforesaid, committed a Riot, or seditious Riot, and with breaking and entering sundry dwelling Houses of various Citizens of said City, and with burning and destroying sundry goods, Chattels and furniture of said Citizens, to the evil example of all others in like cases offending, to the common terror of all good and peaceable inhabitants, and against the peace, Government and dignity of the State. And whereas information has been received at the Executive Department of this State, that the said Leon Syer has fled from Justice, and is now absent from this State and believed to have taken refuge in the States of Louisiana, or in some other Southern or Western State. And it being important and highly necessary for the good of Society, that the perpetrators of such offences should be brought to Justice. Now therefore, I James Thomas Governor of the State of Maryland, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, do hereby Command the said Leon Syer as a fugitive from the Justice of this State, and make known to your Excellency that I have appointed Simon Hays and James H. Jeffers, Police Officers of the City of Baltimore, my agents to receive the said fugitive and bring him to this State, having Jurisdiction
