Tuesday January 5th 1836

This being the day prescribed by the Constitution for the Election of a Council to the Governor, ~~James Harris Esquire~~ of Charles County, John McKerny Esquire, of Queen Anne's County, William F Johnson Esquire, of Baltimore County, Nathaniel H Williams Esquire, of the City of Baltimore, and John C Henry Esquire, of Dorchester County, were, on Joint Ballot of both branches of the General Assembly, elected to that office.

Wednesday January 6th 1836

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John A Alexander or order five hundred dollars for one quarter salary as Topographical Engineer, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Durbin or order seventy five dollars for one quarter salary as astronomer at Frederick due the first instant.

Monday January 11th 1836.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay S Pinkney and R. Waters Esquires, or their order sixty dollars for Books for the State Library, by authority of the Joint Library committee, & certificate of the Librarian, under Resolution of the General Assembly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order thirty five dollars thirty one cent, for the purchase of firewood, to be accounted for.

Thursday January 14 1836

His Excellency Thomas W. Nease, Governor Elect, attended in the Council Chamber, and, at the request of both branches of the General Assembly, communicated by said committee, repairs to the Senate Chamber, and, in the presence of both Houses, qualified as Governor, by taking the oath, prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of the State and repeating and subscribing a declaration
