Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph Townsend Treasurer of the Baltimore Equitable Society or order seventy dollars eighty one cent for contribution on amount of the insurance of State Tobacco Warehouses, to make good damages sustained by fire, for amount.

Monday January 18th 1836

The Governor attended in the Council Chamber and the Honorable John McKenny, William F. Johnson and John C. Henry Councilors elect, appeared in the Council Chamber and were severally qualified as members of the Council, by taking the oaths prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of this State, before William McKenrick Esquire one of the State of Marylands Justices of the peace in and for Anne Arundel County, and by repeating and subscribing a declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order forty four dollars fifty five cents for the purchase of firewood, to be accounted for.
