free Woman of color named Ellen Kilbreath, knowing her to be free with  
intent to sell her as a slave for life, and to have her carried out of this State,  
which said charge was pending against him by Indictment in Washington  
County Court. (See Pardon Record).

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry  
Thompson or order seventy three dollars fifty six cents for the purchase of  
firewood of amount allowed.

Saturday January 23<sup>rd</sup> 1836

The Council met. Present the same as on yesterday.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Nathaniel  
H Williams or order two hundred and fifty dollars, for six months salary  
as a member of the Council, due they first Instant.

half a dollar, which said charge was pending against him by
