To His Excellency Joseph Ritner Governor of the State of Pennsylvania. Whereas a certain Simon Shopp, stands charged by Indictment in Baltimore City Court, with several Acts, with having, on the seventh day of August last, and at divers other days and times between that and the tenth day of the said month, at the City aforesaid, with force and Arms committed a Riot, or Arming Riot, and with breaking and entering sundry dwelling Houses of various Citizens of said City, and with burning and destroying sundry goods and chattels and furniture of said Citizens, to the wil example of all others in like cases offending, to the common terror of all good and peaceable inhabitants and against the Peace Government and dignity of the State of Maryland.
