The following Command was also made upon His Excellency
Joseph Ritner Governor of the State of Pennsylvania for the person therein
named as a fugitive from Justice, upon application and the information
and evidence therein mentioned being received at the Executive Department.

To His Excellency Joseph Ritner Governor of the State of
Pennsylvania. Where as certain William Whitelock stands charged
by Indictment in Baltimore City Court, with several others, with having
on the seventh day of August last, and at divers other days and times between
that and the tenth day of the said month, at the City aforesaid, with force
and arms, committed a Riot, a Sundry Riots, and with breaking and
entering Sundry dwelling Houses of various Citizens of said City, and
with burning and destroying Sundry goods and chattels and furniture
of said Citizens, to the evil example of all others in like cases offending to
the common terror of all good and peaceable inhabitants and against
the Peace Government and dignity of the State of Maryland. And whereas
information has been received at the Executive Department of this State,
that the said William Whitelock has fled from Justice, and is believed
to have taken refuge in the said State of Pennsylvania. And it being
important and highly necessary for the good of Society that the perpetrators
of such Offences should be brought to Justice. - Now therefore, I Thomas
W Neasey Governor of the State of Maryland by ~~virtue~~ of the Authority
vested in me by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, do hereby
demand the said William Whitelock, as a fugitive from the Justice of
this State, and make known to your Excellency that I have appointed
David W Hudson Esquire, Warden of the Jail of Baltimore City and
County, my agent to receive the said fugitive and bring him to this State,
having Jurisdiction of the said offence, that he may be brought to trial
therefor.

In compliance with the requisitions of the Law, I
herewith annex and produce to your Excellency a copy of the indictment
on which this demand is founded, which I certify is authentic.

Given under my hand and the Great Seal of the State
of Maryland, this ninth day of February in the year of our
Great Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six, and of
the Independence of the United States the sixteenth.
