Saturday February 20th 1836.

The Council met. Present the same as on yesterday.

By the petition of George Ballyhooer, and a transcript from the  
Records of Baltimore City Court, it appears that he was fined by the said  
Court at February Term 1836 the sum of five hundred dollars for keeping  
a Billiard Table without License.

The Petitioner represents that he came to the City of Baltimore  
about thirteen years past, where he has continued to keep a public House,  
that in said House he kept a Billiard Table for the use and accommodation  
of his guests; that he annually obtained a License for keeping such Table  
and regularly paid for the same until in the month of April last, when  
forgetting the precise time for the renewal of his License, the day prescribed  
for obtaining the same was negligently permitted to pass, whereby he  
incurred a penalty of five hundred dollars as aforesaid; that as soon as  
he became aware that his License had expired and had not been renewed  
he immediately applied to Baltimore City Court, or the Clerk thereof  
and paid the stipulated price and obtained a renewal of his License.  
He declares and states that the said omission was the result of  
negligence and accident, and proceeded from no wish, disposition or  
intention to defraud the revenue or evade the payment of the Tax or  
License money. He therefore prays for a remission of the said fine.  
And the Clerk of the said City Court, having certified to the truth of  
the material facts in said representation, and the said Court  
having recommended a remission of the said fine. We do hereby  
remit the same.
