By the petition of Archibald McAllister, and a recommendation of the Judges of Baltimore City Court, it appears that a fine of twenty dollars was imposed by the said Court, at February Term instant, upon his wife Elizabeth McAllister for selling whiskey on the Sabbath.

The Petitioner states that said sale was without his knowledge or sanction; that it has been and was proved on the trial to have been his custom not to keep open his shop on Sunday for business and that in this particular instance he was not at home and knew nothing of the transaction. He further states that it has been his intention to submit to the Law on this subject, and that he has repeated in the strongest terms to his family that no sale is to be made by them or any of them on the Sabbath. He therefore prays for a remission of the said fine. And the said Court having certified that within opinion on the facts and correctly stated by the petitioner and that the violation of the Law was not intentional, but induced by a contrivance of the very person who afterwards prosecuted for the penalty, and recommended a remission of said fine - we do hereby remit the same to pay appayable to the State.
