The following message was adopted and sent by the Clerk of the Council to the General Assembly viz

Annapolis March 15th 1836

Gentlemen of the Senate
of the House of Delegates

Under the Resolutions of the General Assembly making appropriations for repairs and improvements of the public buildings within the State House Circle and the Mall and grounds surrounding the same, after giving the required notice for proposals, contracts were made by the late Executive with Messrs Thompson & Gray and Maché Levere for the execution of so much of said improvements as could be made with the sum appropriated, and Doctor Dennis Plante and Jeremiah Hughes and George Wells Esquires, were appointed to Superintend said improvements. The accounts of the contractors have not yet been finally settled, but, by the general statement of the Superintendants, herewith transmitted, it will be seen that the amount appropriated is nearly exhausted, and that to continue and complete the improvements upon the plan of what has been done, will require a further appropriation, which we respectfully recommend to your favorable consideration.
