Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Julius T. Quicater or order five hundred and nineteen dollars twenty cents for contingent expenses of the Geological Survey and examinations, of an amount allowed.

Ordered that the Armorer at Annapolis deliver to Captain Charles Howard one hundred muskets and accoutrements for the use of the first Mechanical Volunteers commanded by the said Captain Howard.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Newnam or order seventy five dollars for one quarter salary as Armorer at Easton due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Mrs Rebecca Hornest or order one hundred and eighty dollars for six months pension due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John M. Keamy or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John A. Alexander or order five hundred dollars for one quarter salary as Topographical Engineer, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George G. Brewer or order seventy five dollars for one quarter salary as Clerk of the House of Delegates, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George G. Brewer or order thirty dollars for Lis of certificates which became ready for patent since the last return, transmitted to the Commissioners of the Tax of the several Counties on the Western Shore, as required by Law.
