

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Johnson or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Washington G. Peck or order twenty five dollars sixty nine cents Ninety for Boxes, packing and unpacking and other expenses of arms, and \$30 for firing powder Salutes, of amount allowed.

His Excellency the Governor this day appointed James Morris and Meris Cohen, additional Aid Camp, and Commissions issued accordingly Ninety.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Thomas Ramey or order one hundred and seventeen dollars twelve cents for balance of one quarter salary as Examiner General (after deducting the amount of fees received) due the first instant, of amount proved.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Isaac Munroe or order five dollars twelve cents for subscription to his paper from 1st of Jan'y 1835 to 25 Jan'y 1836 of amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William McNeil or order thirty dollars for printing forms for the Executive of amount allowed.

To John Turbot on amount of assaulting a constable, with which he stood charged by Indictment in Anne Arundel County Court.

To Samuel Whittington, on amount of assaulting and beating, with a Cow Side William Soper a Constable; and also on amount of assaulting and beating William Aringer with a Cow Side, with which he stood charged, by two several Indictments in Calvert County Court. (See Pardon Record)

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph A. Nicholson or order thirty seven dollars fifty cents for one quarter salary as Clerk of the Senate, due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay James N. Mathews or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary
