Thursday April 7th 1836.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Durbin or order seventy five dollars for one quarter salary as a surgeon at the barracks due the first Instant.

Thursday April 28th 1836.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay John Bacon, Treasurer of the Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf & Dumb, or to his order eight hundred and ninety six dollars forty three cents for tuition boarding clothing &c of indigent pupils of the State of Maryland, up to the first Instant, as provided for by Law, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Mrs Anne Seracke or order forty dollars for one quarter Pension due the first Instant.

His Excellency the Governor this day granted the following Pardons

To Samuel Adams, for Stealing, to the amount of \$164, for which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court, at February Term 1836, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for eight years.

To John Blake, on account of permitting unlawful gaming, in his house, for which he was convicted in Washington County Court, at March Term 1836, and for which he was fined \$50, and sentenced to 30 days imprisonment.

To Daniel Julius, on account of an assault & battery with intent to kill, for which he was convicted in Washington County Court, at March Term 1836, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for five years. (See Pardon Record)

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Richard S.
