

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Adams & Shaw Miller or order twenty four dollars fifty cents for freight on various Parcels allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay George W. Hughes or order five hundred dollars, or amount of the expenses of the survey of a route from Canada from the District of Columbia to the City of Annapolis - to be accounted for.

By the petition of Absalom White, and a transcript from the Records of Cecil County Court, it appears that a recognizance was entered into by the said Absalom White with James Egard for the appearance of the said James Egard before Cecil County Court as a Witness, and that the said Recognizance has been forfeited. And the Judges of the said Court having stated that they have been satisfied that the failure of the Witness to appear according to the recognizance was the result of a mistake and not of a design to do wrong, and also that they were satisfied that no mischief has arisen thereby, inasmuch as the party charged as a criminal has now been arrested, and the said Court having recommended the petitioners case as one proper for Executive Clemency - Upon consideration of the said representation and statements, we do hereby remit the said forfeiture.

By the petition of Henry Brauner, and a transcript from the Records of Charles County Court, it appears that the said Henry Brauner entered into Recognizance with John S. Mackin jointly and severally in the sum of fifty dollars each for the appearance of the said John S. Mackin before the said County Court at March Term 1835 to answer a presentment of, and that the same has been forfeited. The Petitioner states that the said presentment was for stealing one log of wood, and that Mackin being an ignorant and timid man and fearing that he would be sentenced to the Penitentiary, did not appear, but ran off from the State. And two of the Judges of the said Court having recommended a remission of the said forfeiture, we do hereby remit the same.
