hundred dollars for making index to said Journal, of contracts, and  
amount allowed. -

Ordered that the Armorer at Annapolis deliver to Colonel  
Robert Sutton or order four hundred Muskets and one hundred cartridges  
Boxes and belts and six pair of Pistols & Sabres for the use of the 39th  
Regiment of Militia in the City of Baltimore, under his command. -

Ordered that the Armorer at Annapolis deliver to Captain  
Benjamin Vanhook or order fifty Rifles and accoutrements for the use of  
the
