

Wednesday June 11th 1836

The Council met - Present the same as on yesterday.

In the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council, the following civil appointments were made, and commissions issued accordingly, viz.

Peter W. Gibbons, Henry Hays, Samuel McFarquhar, Thomas Gorsuch (for meeting House) Edward Howard (11th District), Abraham H. Price and George Cliff, additional Justices of the Peace, of Baltimore County.

Samuel McFarquhar, a Justice of the 5th Election District Court
Vice Samuel McFarquhar appointed by mistake.

Robert Hamilton, a Visitor of the Jail of Baltimore City & County Vice Marsh declined.

James B. Latimer, additional Justice of the Peace of Baltimore County residing in the City of Baltimore, with Special Limited Jurisdiction.

Peter W. Gibbons a Justice of the first Election District Court for Baltimore County Vice Andrew Hoke Jr. declined.

Joseph Steele, chief Justice of the 3rd Election District Court of Baltimore County Vice Hudson declined, and Joshua Gish associate Justice of said Court Vice Steele promoted.
