

The following orders were signed for the surrender of the person therein named as a fugitive from Justice, upon the Demand and information and evidence therein mentioned. To wit:

The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Cecil County, Greeting,
Whereas it appears from authentic documents certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency Joseph Ritner Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain Alexander Barr stands charged by Indictment in the Mayor's Court of the City of Philadelphia, for the crime of Larceny committed within the said City, and that the said Alexander Barr has fled from the Justice of the said State, and is now imprisoned in Elkton, Cecil County, in this State. And whereas the said Joseph Ritner, Governor as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the Authority given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said Alexander Barr of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice, and appointed James Young his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania, for trial for the said offence. Now therefore, I Thomas W. Peazey Governor of the State of Maryland, have thought proper, in compliance with the said demand, to order and direct the Surrender of the said fugitive, and I do hereby order and direct the you, forthwith, deliver the said Alexander Barr, if he is in your custody to the said James Young agent as aforesaid, he the said agent first paying the costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitive - for all which this shall be your sufficient Warrant.
