

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard M. Chase or order four hundred and forty five dollars for the services of the Troops under his command called out to quell the riot on the Baltimore and Washington Rail Road, under Resolution of the General Assembly, & payroll allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Captain George L. Stockell or order fifty five dollars for the services of part of the Troops under his command, called out to quell the riot on the Baltimore & Washington Rail Road, under Resolution of the General Assembly & payroll allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Jeremiah Hughes or order nineteen hundred and sixty eight dollars seventy five cents for publishing books for publication of the Laws \$3, for publishing notice for proposals for printing the Militia Law \$1.75, for two thousand copies of the Militia Law \$176, for publishing Sunday Laws and furnishing 22 editors therewith \$72, for publishing meeting of the Council \$1, for making bound to Journals of December Session 1835 & May 1836 \$200, for boxes for packing the Journals \$42.50, for 4 Bds Windsor Cord \$2.50, and for balance for printing Journals of the House of Delegates after deducting \$2500 advanced on that account, \$1470, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Shaw W. Kocanda or order seven hundred and fifty dollars, or amount of contingent expenses of the Survey with a view to a new State Map, to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William McHair or order two hundred and seventy dollars fifty cents for printing the Journal of the Senate at May Session 1836, \$172, for making bound to said Journal \$50, and for boxes for and packing the same \$25.50 & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Adam S. Miller or order four dollars thirty cents for freight on articles for the Library, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Cannon or order five dollars for alterations in the Court of Appeals furniture, & amount allowed.
