

The following Warrants were issued for the Surrender of the persons therein named as fugitives from Justice upon the Demand and Implications and Evidence therein mentioned &c

The State of Maryland, To the Sheriff of Baltimore County, or any other County in this State, greeting. Whereas it appears from authentic documents certified and transmitted to the Executive Department of this State, by His Excellency Joseph Ritner Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, that a certain Conrad Moore stands charged by Indictment of the Court of Quarter Sessions for the County of York with the State of Pennsylvania, with fornication and bastardy, and that the said Conrad Moore has fled from the Justice of the said State, and is now in the State of Maryland. And whereas the said Joseph Ritner Governor as aforesaid, hath, in pursuance of the authority given in such cases by the Constitution and Laws of the United States, demanded the said Conrad Moore of the Executive of this State, as a fugitive from Justice and appointed Adam Eichelberger Esquire his agent to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania for trial for the said offence. Now therefore, I Thomas W. Neasey Governor of the State of Maryland have thought proper, in compliance with the said demand to view and direct the Surrender of the said fugitive, and do hereby order and direct that you forthwith, arrest and deliver the said Conrad Moore, if he is in your bailiwick, to the said Adam Eichelberger agent as aforesaid, the said agent first paying you all costs of the arrest and detention of the said fugitive - for all which this shall be your sufficient Warrant.

The State of Maryland to wit. Whereas in compliance with a demand of His Excellency Joseph Ritner Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, orders have been given for the Surrender of a certain Conrad Moore as a fugitive from the Justice of the said State to Adam Eichelberger Esq. agent duly appointed to receive the said fugitive and transport him to the said State of Pennsylvania: it appearing from authentic documents transmitted to the Executive Department of this State that the said Conrad Moore stands charged by Indictment of the Court of Quarter Sessions for the County of York with the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, with fornication and bastardy. Now therefore, I Thomas W. Neasey Governor of the State of Maryland do hereby require and enjoin all persons within this State to let the said Adam Eichelberger pass as aforesaid pass with the said fugitive unimpeded to the said State of Pennsylvania; he the said agent conducting himself in a peaceable and orderly manner, and using no violence, impetuosity, or cruelty in his treatment of the said prisoner.
