

The highest number of Votes for said County, and to Joseph Richardson who
had an equal number of Votes with Fitzhugh & Johnson for Sheriff of said County,
and the Clerk of the Council was instructed to issue a Commission to the
person having the highest number of Votes for Sheriff of said County and
County upon the receipt of the Clerk of said County having furnished
the number of Votes returned for each of the persons returned elected as
aforesaid and the said Clerk of the Council was also instructed to issue
a Commission for Sheriff of Calvert County, upon the receipt of Returns
of the late Election in that County to the person who shall be returned
as having the highest number of Votes.

The said Land was surveyed by act of the last General Assembly for
building a new Customs Warehouse and for the purchase of a Lot of ground
adjacent to the same and the said John Russell King, as having been
accepted, and contracts having been made for the purchase of the said
Lot of ground and for the erection of the said Warehouse, and a deed
of conveyance for the said Lot of ground having been executed and
submitted to and approved by the Governor & Council, the following
certificates of the said State chargeable upon the said John Russell
Richardson are issued viz.

To the said Council King for \$4933:55 payable six months
after date, ^{with interest thereon at the rate of six per centum per annum} the said
in full for the balance due them for the said Lot of ground, with interest
up to this date.

To Joseph & William Murphy two certificates of \$2500
dollars each, one payable six months and the other twelve months
after date, payable as aforesaid.
