

Saturday October 15th 1836.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the order of
Dr James Clarks & Jeremiah Hughes, commissioners on the public circle
thirty five hundred dollars on account of the appropriation for improvement
of said circle. —

Thursday October 20th 1836.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the order
of John Bacon, Treasurer of the Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf & Dumb
nine hundred and ninety seven dollars and ninety one cents, being for the
tuition, support, cloathing &c of pupils from the State of Maryland
at the Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf & Dumb as per draught dated
the fifteenth of the present month. —

Saturday October 22nd 1836

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Wm. Duff
on his order fifty four dollars & 50¢ for publishing Sunday Laws of Decem-
ber 1835, by direction of the Clerk of the Council, under a Resolution of the
General Assembly, and \$4 for publishing Proclamation of Congressional
Election as required by Law, of amount allowed. —

Wednesday October 26th 1836

His Excellency the Governor granted the following Poles
Pardon's &c.

To Daniel Beyer a Pole Proqui on account of stealing with
which he was charged by indictment in Baltimore City Court, to which he
had plead guilty. —

To John Jones, a Pole Proqui, on account of stealing, with
which he was charged by indictment and found guilty by the Court, in
Baltimore City Court at October Term 1836. —

To Absalom Chambers, on account of stealing a watch, of which
he was convicted in April 1832, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary
for seven years. —

Monday October 31st 1836.

His Excellency the Governor granted a Pardon to Robert Frazier
on account of Felony, of which he was convicted in Allegany County Court,
at October Term 1836, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for
two years.

on her order thirteen dollars fifty cents for cleaning the public Spleen in months up to
the first Instant. —
