On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and
with the advice and consent of the Council Doctor Thomas E. Bond
was appointed a Director of the Penitentiary Nic Miles resign, and
commission issued to him accordingly.

By the petition of John B. Mills and James Mahoney, and
transcripts from the Records of Charles County Court, it appears that they
entered into two Recognizances, in the sum of one hundred dollars each
in each of said Recognizances as securities for the appearance of Philip
Porter before Charles County Court, at March Term 1835 to answer to
two presentments against him in said County, and that the said Recognizances
have been forfeited. And two of the Judges of the said Court
having stated that in these cases the Court were anxious that Philip
Porter should leave the State, and think that it would have been better
for the interest of the State that Porter should have run off, than that
his securities should detain him, and therefore recommended a remission of
the forfeited Recognizance. And do thereby hereby remit the same.
