His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to

To Patrick Cratty, on account of murder, in the 2nd degree; of which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court on the 14th of April 1832, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for fifteen years.

To William Appleton, on account of stealing a coat, of which he was convicted in Baltimore City Court on the 12th day of February 1836, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for five years.

Tuesday November 29th 1836

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Thompson or order thirty eight dollars and twenty six cents for the purchase of firewood for the use of the State, to be accounted for.

Saturday December 3rd 1836

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Dennis Claude & Jeremiah Hughes or to their order one thousand five hundred dollars, the balance of the appropriation for the wall and circle around the State House, & Resolution of the General Assembly, to be accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay J. & N. Barker or order fifteen dollars for the Tri-weekly Baltimore Republican for three years for the Executive, & amount allowed.

Monday December 5th 1836

His Excellency the Governor this day granted a Pardon to Frederick Robinson, Negro, on account of receiving stolen goods, knowing the same to have been stolen; of which he was convicted in Queen Anne's County Court, at November Term 1836, and for which he was sentenced to the Penitentiary for two years.
