Ordered that the Armourer at Easton deliver to Captain William Camp twelve pair of Horses for the use of the Troop under his command.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Rachel Green or order eleven dollars fifty six cents for Laundry Ann. this week for the State buildings, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Henry Basil or order one dollar sixty two cents for Sweeping Chimnies at the Government House, & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William H. Stewart or order thirty dollars as follows viz for the Proclamation condemning the Legislature \$20, for the Proclamation of the result of the Election of Electors of President and Vice President of the United States, and \$5 for publishing meetings of the Council, & amount allowed.

Saturday January 14 1837.

The Council met - Present the same as on yesterday.

On the nomination of His Excellency the Governor, and by and with the advice and consent of the Council Thomas J. McKay was appointed an additional Notary Public to reside at Cumberland in Allegany County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Captain Joseph Sands or order two dollars sixty two cents for freight on articles for the Library & amount allowed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Nathaniel H. Williams or order one hundred and twenty five dollars for one quarter salary as a member of the Council due the first instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay William Durbin or order seventeen dollars eleven cents for transportation of Arms, & account allowed.

Monday January 16th 1837.

His Excellency Thomas W. Weazey Governor, and Messrs Johnson & Jones, members of the Council attended.

From Tuesday the 17th to Friday the 27th Inst His Excellency Thomas W. Weazey attended, but no members of the Council.
